

## **CLC Conducted Transfer Vote – November 24 and 25, 2005**

The CLC made the determination that MUSA CLC Local 2003-1 would need to be transferred and conducted a vote on November 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>, 2005. At this point, only four affiliates of the CLC continued to express an interest to represent MUSA and were included on the ballot. The four Unions were: CAW, CUPE, PSAC and USWA. Over the next two days, MUSA Members exercised their democratic right in casting their vote for the union they felt would best represent them.

The outcome of the vote was that 65.8% of the Membership had voted to be transferred to the CAW!

CUPE received 9.6% of the votes cast, PSAC received 6.6% of the votes cast and USWA received 18.0% of the votes cast.
