Members,

Are you interested in taking a family holiday with your Union? Consider applying for the **CAW's 2011 Summer Family Education Program**. The program is held at the CAW Family Education Centre in Port Elgin, Ontario on the shores of Lake Huron.

It's a summer vacation where accommodation, travel costs and meals are paid for. You receive one or two weeks in an environment as comfortable as your own home, where qualified childcare staff look after your children. It's also a chance to meet people from across Canada and to think, read about and discuss current economic and social issues from a worker's viewpoint, as well as the history, structure and policies of our Union. There are also programs for teenagers (ages 13 to 18), children (ages 5 to 12) and daycare for infants (up to age 4). **Participation** in classes and all other planned activities is **mandatory** for ALL family members.

The program is open to all CAW members and their immediate family. For the purpose of the program, '*immediate family*' is spouse/partner and dependent children (up to age 18 only), and does *not* include grandchildren, nieces, nephews, etc. The CAW Family Education Program is funded through the National Union and not through the Paid Education Leave (PEL) fund, and as such, **members must use their own vacation time**.

The dates for the three (3) sessions for this year are as follows:

Session 1 - **Saturday 2 July 2011 to Saturday 9 July 2011** - 1 Week ENGLISH Program
Session 2 - **Sunday 24 July 2011 to Friday 5 August 2011** - 2 Week FRENCH Program
Session 3 - **Sunday 14 August 2011 to Sunday 21 August 2011** - 1 Week ENGLISH Program
